Tips: try this 'clean' way of following the verses each day and use S.O.A.P.!

Scripture - Read the verses 2 or 3 times.

Observe - What is happening in the verses, what do they mean? Who are they written by? Who are they written to? When were they written?

Apply - How does this apply to your life today, and does it mean you need to do something different?

Pray - Thank God, and ask Him to help you apply this to your life, and show you the real Christmas this year.



NOTE: Some of these verses are:-

- a part of the nativity story
- to prepare our hearts for celebrating Christmas
- to think and reflect on who it is we are waiting for
- looking forward to 2016
